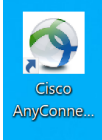


Connect to Cisco Anyconnect VPN

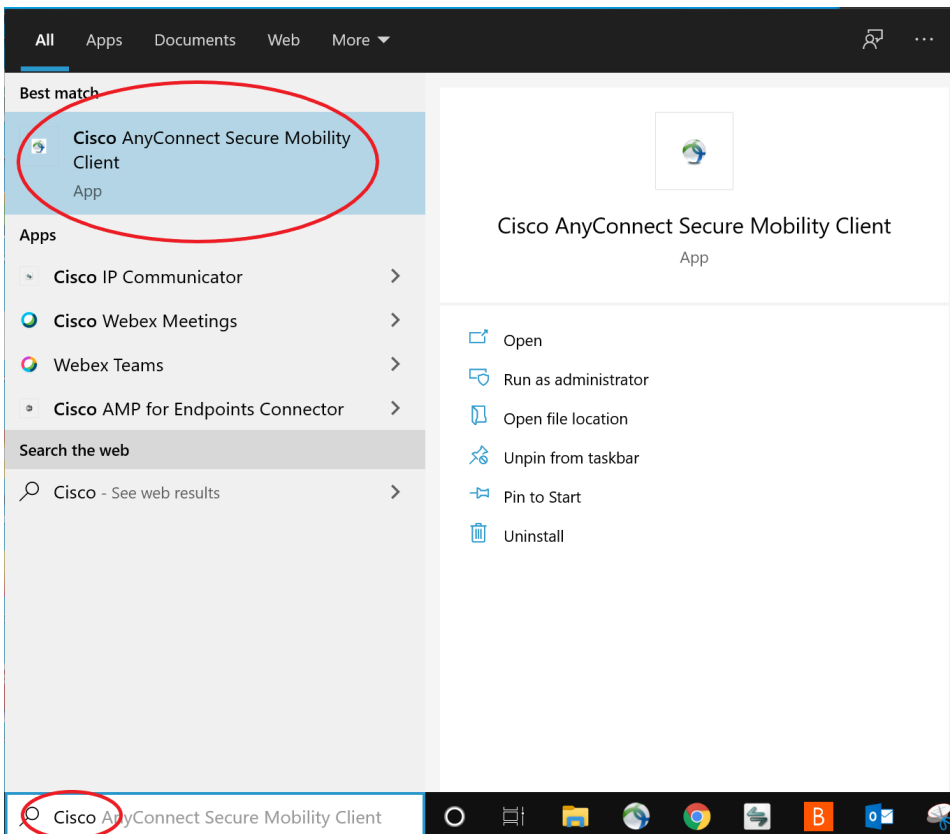
After Cisco AnyConnect VPN is installed, use this guide to get connected.

Step-by-step guide

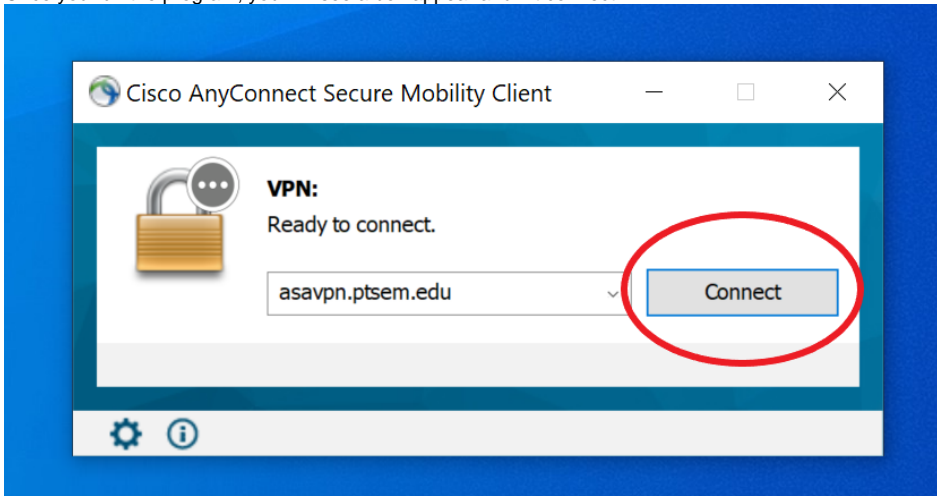
1. Run Cisco Anyconnect by clicking its icon on your desktop




2. If you don't see the icon, use the search to find it. If you have a Mac - use Spotlight to search (command + spacebar)



3. Once you run the program, you will see a box appear and hit connect.



4. A second box will appear for you to sign in with your credentials and hit OK
